- An important aspect of student life at Grace is corporate worship and fellowship. Therefore, regular attendance at chapel services and Sunday services in an evangelical church is required of all full-time students.
- As a part of the Grace commitment to a distinctive life-style and experience, students are to refrain from the use of alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs and tobacco, and from sexual misconduct, gambling, dancing, cheating, theft, coarse or obscene language, or any other conduct inconsistent with the goals and traditions of the college. Further, Grace deplores the morally degrading aspects of the theatre, entertainment media and literature and students are to abstain from all aspects that morally degrade.
